Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires that parents or guardians who have children attending a Title I school be notified of how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or a career, as well as the school's designation status under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools are designated as Reward, Priority, Focus, or Alert schools. The Waiver also allows the use of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI), which serves as a comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia.

I am very proud to tell you that Mountain Education Charter High School has not been given a school designation this year, which means we are continuing to provide a quality education to all of our students. This designation is based on our school's performance in 2016. Under State law HB251 Title 1 schools are subject to Intradistrict Transfer Option for students. Mountain Charter High School is exempt based on our Charter school status.

Many opportunities are provided to students at Mountain Education Charter High School to help them graduate. Title 1 provides additional math teachers to assist students who are having difficulty mastering mathematical concepts. Mentors and graduation coaches support students as they follow their Life Action Plan.

An important part of Mountain Education Charter High School's success is parent participation and support in developing activities to improve student achievement. We hope that you will become involved in our school improvement work as we continue to monitor student achievement and set high expectations.
